Gospel- Jesus, God's only Son, became human. The Sovereign himself became the Vassal. So he could keep his own Covenant obligations- Jesus' life. He also would take on the curse from our sinful consuming. On the cross, Jesus the Son, was cursed. He was betrayed by his friends, put outside the city, and lost the fellowship of his Father. He died.

In his resurrection, he reversed the curse. He defeated the curse of sin, death, and now has given his Holy Spirit to the church, his people and is bringing the Kingdom of God back for the people of God to enjoy fellowship with God and each other forever. In the meantime, He has called the church into new covenant obligations- to be fruitful and multiply the children of God through the proclamation of the gospel and the obedience of his commands.
